

Constitution of the

Getman Family of America Reunion

This is a copy of a document in the possession of Eleanor and Florence Getman.

ARTICLE I—NAME

This organization shall be known as the GETMAN FAMILY OF AMERICA.

ARTICLE II—OBJECT

The object of this organization shall be the uniting of all the branches and members of the family into a closer acquaintanceship and fellowship, the perpetuation of the family history and records, and such other objects as may hereafter be determined.

ARTICLE III—MEMBERS

Every person, male and female, who is a member of the Getman family, shall he and is, by virtue of that fact, eligible as a member of this organization.

ARTICLE IV—OFFICERS

Section 1. The officers of this organization shall consist of a Board of Ten Directors, five of whom shall hold office for one year, and five for two years, and thereafter five shall be elected annually for two years.

Section 2. The Board of Directors shall annually elect from their number a President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Historian to serve one year.

Section 3. The organization shall meet annually on the third Wednesday in June and the place for the meeting shall be determined annually by the organization.

ARTICLE V—DUTIES OF OFFICERS

Section 1. The President shall act as presiding officer, appoint all committees, and call special meetings of the Board of Directors when deemed necessary.

Section 2. The Vice President shall act as President in the absence or disability of the President to act.

Section 3. The Secretary shall attend all meetings of the organization and of the Board of Directors. He shall enroll, in a book provided for that purpose, the names of all members of the organization, together with their addresses; keep minutes of all meetings of the organization and Board of Directors.

Section 4. The Treasurer shall collect all funds and pay all bills and report at the annual meeting all receipts and disbursements.

Section 5. Any vacancy in the Board of Directors shall be filled at an annual meeting in the usual way.

ARTICLE VI

The Board of Directors shall meet immediately after election to organize, and thereafter on the call of the President.

ARTICLE VII

The duties of the Historian shall be to make all historical and genealogical researches and make a duplicate record, one copy to be deposited with the Secretary and to be surrendered to his successor, and one to be kept in possession of Historian.

ARTICLE VIII—DUES

The dues shall be 50 cents, more or less, annually for persons over twenty-one years of age.

ARTICLE IX

Amendments to the constitution may be made by any member with the consent of two-thirds of the members present.
